Ages 12-17 • Ages 18 and older
All original, one-of-a-kind, non-production hanging artwork is welcome. Entries must be appropriate for all audiences; jurors reserve the right to decline inappropriate entries. Artwork must be gallery-ready (with picture wire) and accompanied by a completed application.

Entry fees
Submit up to 3 works at \$10 per piece (non-refundable), payable when artwork is brought in for jurying on August 5.

Artists are required to depict an aspect of the Carnegie Garden. Find inspiration in the Garden and work with other artists on Plain Air Day, Sat., June 6. An outdoor photography workshop will also be held in the Garden on June 6 at 11 a.m.

Artists are obligated to pay city, county, and state sales tax to appropriate officials.
