



1905 Carnegie Library Public Garden Engraved Flagstone Project

The Pikes Peak Library District Foundation has established an engraved paving stone fund to support the 1905 Carnegie Library Public Garden, located to next to the downtown 1905 Carnegie Library. The garden – a lasting gift to the community – has been constructed through the collaborative efforts of volunteers, businesses, corporations, grants, garden clubs, Friends of the Pikes Peak Library District, library staff, and the Pikes Peak Library District Foundation.



Quality, natural flagstones in keeping with the architecture of the 1905 building are placed in random designs at the entrance of the garden and in paths throughout the garden.
