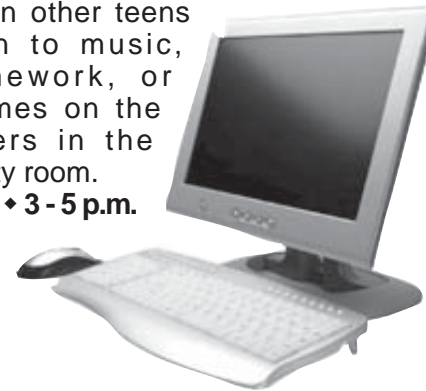
Paws to Read

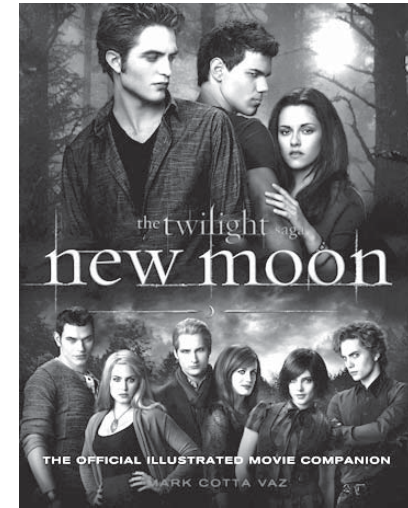
Teens on Laptops

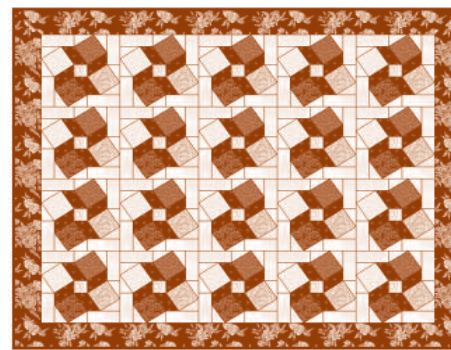

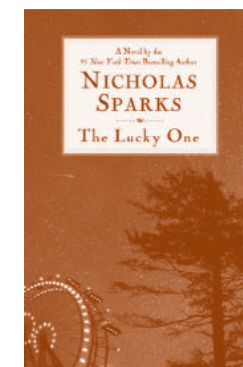
Stitch in the Ditch Quilters

Fountain Book Club

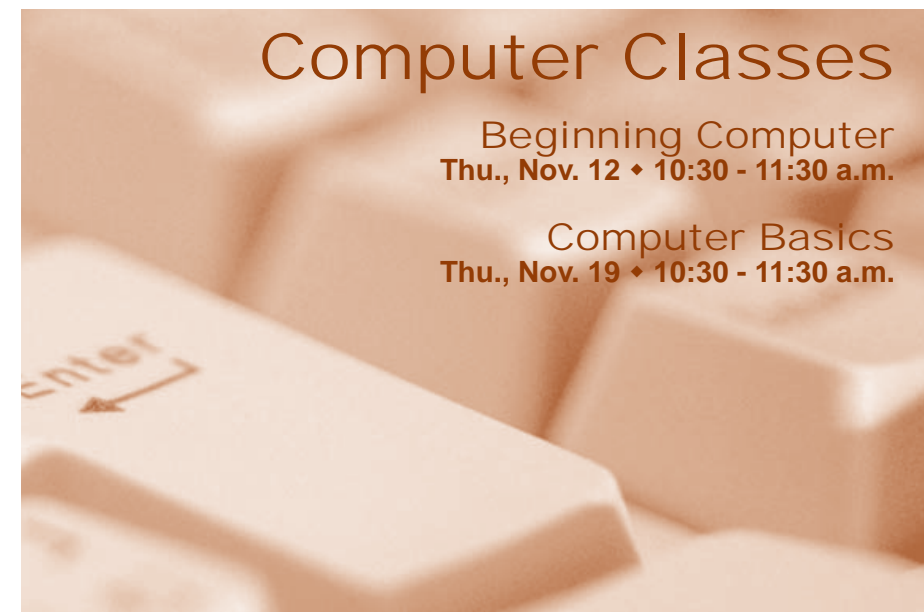
