

CyberShelf: Freading app for iOS (Apple)

All mobile devices are different. For specific instructions, go to: pikespeak.freading.com/questions/index.

What do I need to use the PPLD Freading app for iOS (Apple) devices?

1. A Pikes Peak Library District resident card number (resident card numbers start with a 4) and PIN.
2. A mobile device with wireless Internet access that runs the iOS (Apple) OS.

Download & Transfer Instructions:

Step 1. Download required free app.

- Go to the App Store on your device.
- Search for Freading.
- Install the free app.

Step 2. Create an Adobe ID and authorize your device (first-time use only)

- Open the Freading app.
- In the Freading app, touch the **Menu bar** (three parallel lines in the upper left hand side of the screen).
- Touch **Settings**.
- Touch **Authorize**.
- Touch **Get a free Adobe ID**. Follow the prompts to create an Adobe ID.
- Once it is created, go back to the Freading app.
- Once again, touch the **Menu bar**.
- Touch **Settings**.
- Touch **Authorize**.
- Enter in your Adobe ID and password.

Step 3. Checkout eBooks

- Click on **CyberShelf/Freading** in the upper navbar of ppld.org
- Touch **Login** and enter your library card number and PIN.
- Search or browse for an eBook and touch the cover image.
- Touch **Download EPUB** beneath the cover image of the book you wish to check out. The book will automatically begin to download.
- Your device will ask where you want to download the book. Select the **Freading app**.
- You should be able to read books located in your **Home** screen.
