



CyberShelf: Freegal on your computer

Freegal is a free and legal way to download and keep music forever! You may download up to five songs per week.

What do I need to use PPLD Freegal?

1. A Pikes Peak Library District resident library card number (resident card numbers start with a 4) and PIN.
2. A computer with an Internet connection.

Browsing & Listening/Viewing Instructions:

- Click on **CyberShelf/Freegal** in the upper navbar of ppld.org
- On Click **Login** (upper right corner).
- Log in with your library card number and PIN. Click **Log in**.
- Search or Browse for the song you want to download.
- To preview a song, click the blue arrow:
- To download a song, click the grid icon: 
- Then click **Download Now**. 
- **TIP:** Be sure you want the song. There are no take backs!
- Locate the download file (every internet browser is different). Click where prompted to open the download.
- Your selection will open and play in your default music player (such as iTunes or Windows Media Player).
