

CyberShelf: Freegal app

Freegal is a free and legal way to download and keep music forever! You may download up to three songs per week.

What do I need to use the PPLD Freegal app?

1. A Pikes Peak Library District resident library card number (resident card numbers start with a 4) and PIN.
2. A mobile device with wireless Internet access.

Download Instructions:

Step 1. Download and set up required free app (first-time use only).

- Go to Google Play, App Store, or Windows Store on your device.
- Search for Freegal Music.
- Install the free app.
- On your device, open the Freegal app.
- Decide whether to **Allow** or **Don't Allow** Freegal to use your current location.
- Enter in your location and touch **Go**.
- Touch **Pikes Peak Library District**.
- Enter in your library card number and PIN. Touch **LOGIN**.

Step 2. Find and download music.

- On your device, open the Freegal app.
 - Browse and search for songs.
 - The blue arrow ► allows you to preview a song.
 - The circle with the arrow in it ⬇️ is the download button.
- Once you press this download button, the song downloads.

TIP: Be sure you want the song. There are no take backs!

Step 3. Listen to songs on your device.

- Open the Freegal app.
- Touch **My Music**.
- Touch the ► next to the name of the song you want to hear. Your selection will begin playing.
