Using the Zinio for Libraries app

Availability for the Zinio for Libraries app can be determined by searching through a mobile device's Play Store or App Store.

However, the Kindle Fire and Kindle Fire HD may access the app here:

What do I need to use the PPLD Zinio app?

1. A Pikes Peak Library District card and PIN.
2. A mobile device with wireless Internet access.
3. A computer with Internet access.
4. A Zinio for Libraries account.

Download & Account Registration Instructions:

Step 1. Create a Zinio for Libraries account (first-time use only)

- Click on **CyberShelf/Zinio** in the upper navbar of ppld.org.
- Click on **Create New Account** in the upper right hand corner.
- Enter your Pikes Peak Library District card number. Click **Next**.
- Enter your information to set up an account. At the bottom of the form, click **Create Account**.

Step 2. Checkout eMagazines

- Search by using the search box at the top left of the screen, or click on **All Genres** to browse by genre.
- Click on the cover of the magazine you would like.
TIP: Select the checkbox next to the Checkout button to be notified by email when new issues of this title are available.
- Click on **Checkout**.
- Select and click on either **Keep Browsing** or **Start Reading (PC/Mac Streaming)**, depending on your preference.

Step 3. Download required free app (first-time use only)

TIP: The Zinio for Libraries app allows you to read magazines you have already checked out, but you need to browse

- Go to the Apple Store or Play Store on your device.
- Search for Zinio for Libraries.
- Install the free app.
- Click **LOG IN**.
- Select your country.
(You may need to touch Next to continue the set up.)
- Select your state.
(You may need to touch Next to continue the set up.)
- Begin typing **Pikes Peak Library District**, and select that name from the drop-down list.
(You may need to touch Next to continue the set up.)
- Enter your email address and password and touch **Submit**.

Step 4. Reading eMagazines

- On your device, open the Zinio for Libraries app.
- Your checked out magazines should appear in the app automatically.
*TIP: To synch your app with recent checkouts, begin by touching the **Settings** button (in the upper left hand corner). Touch **Sync Library** in the menu that appears. Touch the **X** to close the settings menu and go back to your reading.*
- Touch on the cover of the magazine you would like. The magazine will begin downloading.
- Swipe to turn pages or tap on the center of the screen to navigate in the magazine.
- Touch on the **x** at the upper left-hand corner of the screen to close the magazine and go back to your Zinio for Libraries collection.
