### Amendment #2

The Terms & Conditions will be updated to show that Firms do not need to have a permanent office in Colorado Springs and Addendum C Immigration Clause for Contracts is not required.

### Questions and Answers

1. Section 1 of the RFP requires that the firm maintain a permanent office in Colorado Springs. Will Firms be disqualified from consideration if they don't?
  - a. No
  
2. Section 5 of the RFP requires submission of a monthly flat fee for "routine matters." As our Firm does not provide such a pricing structure, would our Firm be disqualified from consideration?
  - a. Yes, as we are seeking, with limited public funding, a more predictable budget line-item for simple questions and issues that may arise.
  
3. Addendum C of the RFP (Immigration Clause for Contracts), these clauses are no longer required in public agency contracts in Colorado. Sections 8-17.5-101 to 8-17.5-103, Colorado Revised Statutes, were repealed in 2022. Does PPLD still want bidders to execute Addendum C of the RFP?
  - a. No, the addendum is not required.
