DEFINITIONS

Gentrification: a process of neighborhood change that includes economic change in a historically disinvested neighborhood by means of real estate investment and new higher-income residents moving in, as well as demographic change, in terms of income level, the education level, or racial make-up of residents. (from urbandisplacement.org)

Urban renewal: the process of making a poor area of a city attractive for people to live and work in again by building new houses, offices, schools, etc. and improving the existing ones or the improvement and sometimes replacement of buildings in a city, especially of whole neighbourhoods of housing. (from *Cambridge Dictionary*)

- How can we preserve a neighborhood's culture and history as it changes?
- What are the responsibilities of newcomers, developers, politicians, lenders, and long-time residents in changing neighborhoods like Stratton Meadows and lvywild?
- What are the main causes and effects of gentrification?
- Do common associations with the term "gentrification" stifle thinking about ways to promote inclusive neighborhood change? Or do common associations with the word motivate people to think about ways to foster growth that is inclusive?
- What policies and programs can support neighborhood improvement that benefits long-time residents, renters and homeowners, as well as newcomers?
- What challenges does urban renewal have for us?
