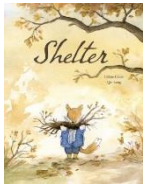
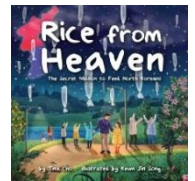


February is “Random Acts of Kindness” month. Enjoy these JEasy Picture Books.

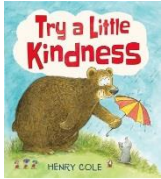

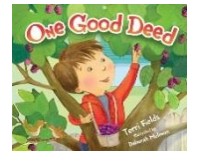
Claire, Celine. [Shelter](#). (Though many refused shelter to two strangers in a storm, will the strangers now show kindness, when someone needs it?)



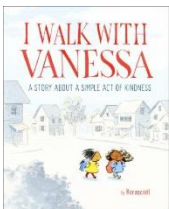
Cho. [Rice from Heaven](#). (Two South Korean children send bags of rice over the border of North Korea, to feed children who are starving).



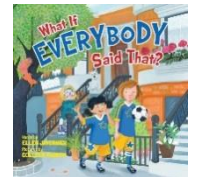
Cole, Henry. [Try a Little Kindness](#). (How many kind things you can do each day?)



Fields, Terri. [One Good Deed](#). (A boy's good deed for a neighbor begins a chain of helpful deeds in the neighborhood.)



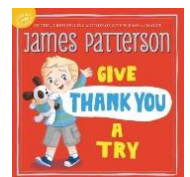
